Shrub Lane is not a wide road and many people park here. Sight lines for the site might be difficult to work out with so many cars parking here. It is already difficult to pull out of Greenfield Road safely, especially as cars drive very fast here moving into and out of the 30 mph speed limit zone. Much of this could be solved with the allocation of parking for the Greenfield Road residents running alongside Greenfield Road. (Greenfield Road is a single track private road with very little parking for the residents as it was built in 1905). The problem with no footpath to the village is still an issue but with only 4 houses it is not as pressing as with the other Shrub lane sites.

No

Comment: I strongly oppose the building on this ancient field for many reasons. Firstly in winter it becomes very waterlogged and there are many underground streams here. I know this as one of these runs under my house and has caused considerable damp problems to my house which became worse when Greenfield Road was resurfaced. Building here would cause even more problems. Then there are the accent hedges around the gate which even with the best will in the world will have to be made smaller to allow for enough space for an entrance to so many houses. Then the lack of footpath to the village (putting a footpath behind the hedge of the site does nothing to allow the pedestrians clear access to the village as there is no footpath from there to the bus stop) and the infrastructure inadequacies plus the lack of employment need to be addressed. However the main consideration must be the SAFETY of building here with bad sightlines, parked cars, no footpath and speeding traffic.

Point 3

Burwash is an unspoilt, historic, charming village, where one of our greatest authors Rudyard Kipling made his home, and who cared passionately about the surrounding countryside, which provided him with inspiration. Burwash maintains strong links to The National Trust through Batemans, whose visitors expect to encounter, in all areas of the village, the rural idyll so often referred to in Kipling's writings. The NT are strong supporters of maintaining AONB, as demonstrated in their management of Batemans, and the surrounding land. It feels incongruous that these proposed building developments, especially larger ones could be considered a viable proposition, given that building developments should reflect the needs, aesthetics, and character of the community, without threatening or violating open spaces, farmland and woodland. I feel that certain of the proposed developments are inappropriate and have a total disregard or empathy for the needs of the village and its inhabitants.

Point 4

The Denton Homes application and appeal has already been rejected by Rother District Council for very valid reasons, as unsuitable for residential development, located in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, and situated outside Rother District Council's development boundary, being over a kilometre from the village.

Approval has been given for 30 new dwellings in Burwash, access to which will be via Shrub Lane and Strand Meadow. I understood that this would fulfil the Burwash housing quota. The entrance to this approved development is only yards away from the proposed Denton Homes development, and all my concerns with regard to the increased volume of traffic in Shrub Lane from that one development, and all the implications thereof, are doubled. I would reiterate that this is a 'lane', not even a B road, and not designed to cope with the inevitable volume of traffic and the dangers that accompany it produced by two nearby estates.

The effect of another 35 houses, will create vastly increased volumes of traffic from various new exits into Shrub Lane, the exits themselves creating potential hazards. Denton Homes' previous assessment of what is an acceptable level of traffic in Shrub Lane, is not an independent view. When assessing traffic volume, account must be taken, not only of the potential increase in traffic from the 35 new houses, but also the 30 new houses mentioned above, and that of traffic caused by visitors to the new estates, and other new houses, as well as delivery vans, lorries, school and local bus services etc. Shrub Lane (Lane being the operative word), already copes with a large volume of traffic, and is not currently maintained to an acceptable standard as it is. There are also pedestrians and dog walkers using the lane, where there are no footpaths at all. The lane narrows significantly in several places including the bridge over the river making it difficult to pass large vehicles.

Point 12

The infrastructure of the village is already under pressure, and it is difficult to envisage how the School, and the Doctor's Surgery would be able to cope with the increase in the population that this number of new houses would generate, not to mention the pressure that would be placed upon the drainage and sewerage systems some of which are very old, as well as other utilities.

Any new building project would inevitably impact the environment and habitat, both on the intended sites and adjoining land, which we should be conserving, protecting and safeguarding for future generations.

This number of houses must constitute a 'major' development which would be harmful to the community, its infrastructure and environment.
